The Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program: Putting Rights First Melanie Kempf, Program Manager for Quality and Process Improvement, Office of the State Long-Term Care Ombudsman

This presentation covers information about the Alzheimer's Association resources, support services and how to get involved in the cause. Learn how behavior changes for those with dementia and how they are a form of communication, identify non-medical approaches to behaviors and recognize when additional help is needed.
